ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND CLOSING DOCKET

(Issued March 3, 2008)

On February 19, 2008, Interstate Power and Light Company, Progressive Foundry Company, Jacobsen Holz Corporation, and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (the settling parties), filed a "Joint Motion and Settlement Agreement" with the Utilities Board (Board). The settling parties request that the Board approve the proposed settlement agreement and dismiss the docket.

On February 5, 2008, the undersigned issued an order granting limited intervention to MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican). The order provided that if the settling parties were able to settle the case, they could do so without the participation and approval of MidAmerican. The settling parties have done so in the proposed settlement agreement.

The proposed settlement agreement is reasonable in light of the whole record, is consistent with applicable law, and is in the public interest. 199 IAC 7.18.

Therefore, the settling parties' motion should be granted and the proposed settlement agreement should be approved. The proposed settlement agreement addresses all disputed issues in the case, and this docket should therefore be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The settlement agreement filed by the settling parties on February 19, 2008, is approved and this docket is closed.
