ORDER DOCKETING PROPOSED TARIFF FILINGS FOR FURTHER REVIEW

(Issued March 26, 2008)

On March 17, 2008, MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariffs reflecting the annual reconciliation of its energy efficiency cost recovery factors. The proposed tariffs have been identified as TF-08-42 (electric) and TF-08-43 (gas).

On March 20, 2008, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed conditional objections to the proposed tariffs. Consumer Advocate stated that the reconciliations are complex and Consumer Advocate needs additional time to complete its review. Consumer Advocate said it would notify the Board when Consumer Advocate's investigation is complete.

The Board will docket the proposed tariff for further review by the Board and Consumer Advocate. The Board will determine whether a procedural schedule needs to be established after the reviews are completed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Tariff filings TF-08-42 and TF-08-43 are docketed for further review.
