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**ORDER EXTENDING SMALL VOLUME GAS
TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM**

(Issued April 28, 2008)

On November 5, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. SPU-04-1 directing MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) to file a permanent small volume gas transportation tariff consistent with certain conditions described in the order. The permanent small volume gas transportation service will replace the existing Small Volume Gas Transportation Pilot Project (Pilot Program) service that is scheduled to end April 30, 2008. On December 28, 2007, MidAmerican filed a proposed compliance tariff to implement the permanent small volume gas transportation service. The proposed tariff was docketed at Docket No. TF-07-220.

On April 14, 2008, MidAmerican filed a revised tariff that reflected discussions between MidAmerican and the parties. MidAmerican indicates that not all of the issues raised by the other parties have been resolved. On April 16, 2008, the Board issued an order establishing a response date to the revised tariff and a date for replies to the responses. On April 21, 2008, responses were filed by Iowa Joint Utility Management Program, Inc., and Cornerstone Energy LLC, d/b/a Constellation NewEnergy-Gas Division, and on April 25, 2008, MidAmerican filed a reply to the

responses. In the reply, MidAmerican indicates that it understands that the Board may not be able to issue an order before April 30, 2008, the date the Pilot Program is scheduled to end, and MidAmerican is not opposed to extending the Pilot Program for a short period to allow the Board to consider the matter and issue an order regarding the permanent tariffs.

As recognized by MidAmerican, the Board will not be able to issue an order concerning the permanent small volume gas transportation tariff before April 30, 2008, because of the extended discussion among the parties concerning the conditions that should be included in the permanent tariff. The Board will extend the Pilot Project tariff for 30 days in order to allow for a full consideration of the unresolved issues that remain regarding the permanent tariff. This will allow the Board sufficient time to issue an order and for MidAmerican to file any revisions to the proposed tariff that may be required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The MidAmerican Energy Company Small Volume Gas Transportation Pilot Project service is extended to May 30, 2008.
