**ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE AND
APPROVING CANCELLATION OF TARIFF**

(Issued May 29, 2008)

On December 26, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity, identified as Certificate No. 0321, to Norlight, Inc. (Norlight), authorizing Norlight to provide local telecommunications service in Iowa. Also on December 26, 2007, the Board approved Norlight's tariff, identified as TF-07-188.

On April 30, 2008, Norlight filed a request to cancel its existing certificate and tariff. Norlight requests the cancellation due to changes in its business plan. Norlight states that it currently has no local exchange customers in Iowa and therefore a cancellation of its certificate will not adversely affect the public.

The Board finds that cancellation of Norlight's certificate is reasonable since Norlight is not providing local exchange service in Iowa and does not have any local exchange customers. If Norlight's business plan changes and it elects to begin

providing local exchange service in Iowa in the future, Norlight may reapply for certification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The request of Norlight, Inc., to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity, identified as Certificate No. 0321, filed April 30, 2008, is granted.

2. The April 30, 2008, request by Norlight, Inc., to cancel its local exchange tariff, identified as TF-07-188, is approved.
