**ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND
REQUESTS FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAR**

(Issued June 9, 2008)

On May 30, 2008, the Iowa Consumers Coalition (ICC) filed a petition with the Utilities Board (Board) to intervene in Docket No. RPU-08-1. This docket involves Interstate Power and Light Company's (IPL) application for determination of ratemaking principles for the proposed Sutherland Generating Station Unit 4 coal-fired electric generation facility in Marshalltown, Iowa.

In support of its petition to intervene, the ICC states that it is an ad hoc group that in this proceeding consists of six large electric customers of IPL. A listing of the ICC's members is contained in the petition to intervene. The ICC further states that IPL's filing could have a substantial impact on the rates and services received by ICC members.

The Board will grant the petition to intervene. The ICC has alleged a unique interest in this proceeding that is not currently represented.

Accompanying the petition to intervene filed by the ICC were requests for permission to appear filed by James M. Bushee, Daniel E. Frank, and Michael N.

Khalil. All three attorneys are members of the same law firm and are licensed to practice law in other states and the District of Columbia, but not Iowa. Attached to the requests was an appearance of Iowa counsel for purposes of service of process pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 31.14. The requests for permission to appear will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The petition to intervene filed by the Iowa Consumers Coalition on May 30, 2008, is granted.

2. The requests for permission to appear filed by James M. Bushee, Daniel E. Frank, and Michael N. Khalil are granted.
