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**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

(Issued June 10, 2008)

On December 21, 2007, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. 199 IAC 15.3 requiring Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) to file an amended 2006 Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA) Report pursuant to 199 IAC 15.3 and revised standard avoided cost tariff rates for small qualifying facilities (QFs), based on its amended 2006 PURPA Report. The amended 2006 PURPA Report and revised tariff rates were to contain revisions required by the Board in its December 21, 2007, order. The required revisions were further clarified by an order issued April 10, 2008.

IPL filed its amended 2006 PURPA Report and proposed tariff changes on May 12, 2008. No responses to the tariff revisions have been filed.

IPL's proposed tariff rates increase its non-time differentiated avoided cost energy rate by 10.9 percent, from 3.57 cents per kWh to 3.96 cents per kWh. Seasonal and time-of-day rates are also increased, as is IPL's optional capacity payment. The proposed changes to IPL's small avoided cost purchase rates are

consistent with IPL's amended 2006 PURPA report and the Board's previous orders.

The tariff will be approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

Tariff filing TF-08-71 is approved, effective June 12, 2008, subject to complaint or investigation.
