ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

(Issued July 3, 2008)

On June 24, 2008, the Utilities Board (Board) issued an order in Docket No. EEP-08-3 severing a proposed Revenue Normalization Mechanism (RNM) filed by Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks (Aquila), in that docket and directing Aquila to file any written testimony and exhibits regarding the RNM in Docket No. RPU-08-3 on or before July 8, 2008. On July 1, 2008, Aquila filed a motion to extend the filing deadline for the testimony and exhibits regarding the RNM from July 8 to July 17, 2008. Aquila states the extension is necessary to allow Aquila a full and fair opportunity to consider and assess the effect the transfer of the RNM proposal will have on the other issues in Docket No. RPU-08-3.

Aquila states that the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate), currently the only other party in Docket No. RPU-08-3, has reviewed the motion and authorized counsel for Aquila to state and represent that Consumer Advocate has no objection to the granting of the motion.

The Board will grant the motion and extend the filing deadline for testimony and exhibits regarding the RNM in Docket No. RPU-08-3. The Board understands

that the inclusion of the RNM in Docket No. RPU-08-3 may affect other issues in that docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The motion filed by Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks, on July 1, 2008, is granted.
2. Testimony and exhibits regarding the Revenue Normalization Mechanism shall be filed in Docket No. RPU-08-3 on or before July 17, 2008,
