**ORDER RECOGNIZING CORPORATE NAME CHANGE,
APPROVING TARIFF, AND ISSUING AMENDED CERTIFICATE**

(Issued July 9, 2008)

On April 21, 2008, PrairieWave Telecommunications, Inc. (PrairieWave), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a letter of notification indicating a corporate name change from PrairieWave to Knology of the Plains, Inc. (Knology). In support of its request, PrairieWave states that neither the ownership structure of the company nor its principals were affected by the name change. Knology has filed a proposed replacement local exchange tariff reflecting the corporate name change and accurately reflecting the exchanges in which Knology intends to provide local service. Revisions to the proposed tariff were filed on June 9, 2008. The proposed tariff and its revisions have been identified as TF-08-58.

The Board will recognize the change in the corporate name of PrairieWave Telecommunications, Inc., to Knology of the Plains, Inc. The Board has also reviewed the proposed replacement tariff and finds that the tariff and its revisions substantially comply with Board rules regarding tariffs and can be approved. The

Board will issue an amended certificate concurrently with this order reflecting the corporate name change.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to the filing of April 21, 2008, in this matter, the Board recognizes the corporate name change from PrairieWave Telecommunications, Inc., to Knology of the Plains, Inc.

2. The proposed replacement tariff identified as TF-08-58 filed by Knology of the Plains, Inc., on April 21, 2008, and revised on June 9, 2008, is approved effective upon the issuance of this order.

3. Amended Certificate No. 0252 is being issued concurrently with this order. Under this amended certificate, Knology of the Plains, Inc., will be allowed to provide local exchange service in Iowa as shown by its tariffs as currently and subsequently approved.
