**ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

(Issued July 18, 2008)

On July 17, 2008, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) an unresisted motion to extend the deadline for Consumer Advocate and any intervenors to file written testimony and exhibits in Docket No. EEP-08-3. Consumer Advocate said Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks (Aquila), agreed to extend the deadline from August 1 to August 11, 2008, for Consumer Advocate and any intervenors to file testimony and exhibits. The parties also agreed to extend the time for Consumer Advocate and intervenor rebuttal testimony from August 15 to August 22, 2008, if any party should intervene in the docket. Currently, Aquila and Consumer Advocate are the only parties to the proceeding. In support of the motion, Consumer Advocate said the additional time for its testimony was necessary due to delays in discovery because of the number of data requests and Aquila's current business relocation process. Consumer Advocate said other procedural dates should not be impacted.

The Board will grant the motion and modify the procedural schedule. The parties have agreed to the new dates and extending the time for Consumer

Advocate's testimony will not impact other procedural dates, such as the hearing date.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The procedural schedule established by Board order issued June 11, 2008, is modified as follows:

a. The Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice and any intervenors shall file prepared direct testimony, with underlying workpapers and exhibits, on or before August 11, 2008. If a party references a data request in its prepared testimony, the data request shall be filed as an exhibit.

b. If Consumer Advocate and any intervenors find it necessary to file testimony in rebuttal to each other's direct testimony, they shall file rebuttal testimony on or before August 22, 2008.

2. All other aspects of the procedural schedule issued June 11, 2008, are unchanged.
