**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND CLOSING DOCKET**

(Issued July 21, 2008)

On June 26, 2007, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) and MCC Telephony of Iowa, Inc. (MCC), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a complaint against Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc., d/b/a Iowa Telecom (Iowa Telecom), alleging that Iowa Telecom was acting in a manner inconsistent with the Trading Partner Profile incorporated into the Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) between the parties, which relates to the processing of customer orders. Sprint and MCC stated that Iowa Telecom's actions were in violation of the Board's November 9, 2006, order in Docket No. FCU-06-49, Iowa Code § 476.100, 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120, and certain North American Numbering Council standards.

On August 21, 2007, the Board issued an order granting a joint motion for a temporary stay of this proceeding. The Board granted the stay based on the parties'

assertions that they were attempting to memorialize an agreement on the issues raised in Sprint and MCC's complaint.

On July 15, 2008, Sprint and MCC filed a dismissal of their June 26, 2007, complaint against Iowa Telecom. Sprint and MCC state that the issues raised in their complaint have been resolved by the final interconnection agreement between Sprint and Iowa Telecom, which was arbitrated by the Board in Docket No. ARB-07-2. Therefore, Sprint and MCC ask to dismiss their complaint.

The Board has reviewed Sprint and MCC's request for dismissal and finds that it is reasonable. The Board will dismiss Sprint and MCC's complaint against Iowa Telecom filed on June 26, 2007, and will close this proceeding identified as Docket No. FCU-07-9.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. The request for dismissal of this proceeding filed by Sprint Communications Company L.P. and MCC Telephony of Iowa, Inc., on July 15, 2008, is granted.
2. This proceeding, identified as Docket No. FCU-07-9, is closed.
