ORDER ACCEPTING FILING

(Issued July 21, 2008)

On July 11, 2008, Community Energy Solutions, Iowa Environmental Council, Iowa Farmers Union, Iowa Physicians for Social Responsibility, and Iowa Renewable Energy Association (collectively, the Coalition) filed a motion with the Utilities Board (Board) to deem the filing of the Coalition's direct testimony and accompanying documents in Docket No. RPU-08-1 timely. In support of the motion, the Coalition said that the direct testimony was initially filed on July 8, 2008, the deadline for filing the Coalition's testimony. However, the filing did not comply with the Board's rules because confidential material was not separated from the public version of the filing. The Coalition stated there was insufficient time to separate the confidential material during business hours on July 8, so the confidential material was separated and the direct testimony and accompanying documents refiled on July 9, 2008.

The Board will accept the filing. The one-day delay in filing so the confidential material could be separated does not substantially prejudice any party to these proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The direct testimony and accompanying documents filed by Community Energy Solutions, Iowa Environmental Council, Iowa Farmers Union, Iowa Physicians for Social Responsibility, and Iowa Renewable Energy Association on July 9, 2008, is accepted.
