**ORDER REQUIRING TARIFF FILING AND AMENDED PURPA REPORT**

(Issued August 13, 2008)

Pursuant to 199 IAC 15.5(3), each rate-regulated electric utility is required to file and maintain tariffs with the Utilities Board (Board) specifying standard avoided cost tariff rates that apply to utility purchases of electricity from small qualifying facilities (QFs) with a design capacity of 100 kW or less. Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) previously filed with the Board revisions to its small QF tariff based on its amended 2006 biennial report of Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (PURPA) avoided cost information (PURPA Report) filed pursuant to 18 CFR 292.302, 199 IAC 15.3, and in response to Board orders issued December 21, 2007, and April 10, 2008, in Docket No. 199 IAC 15.3.

On June 30, 2008, IPL filed its 2008 PURPA Report, which shows estimated avoided costs higher than those in its amended 2006 PURPA Report. Therefore, IPL will be required to revise its standard avoided cost tariff rates for small QFs filed under 199 IAC 15.5(3), based on the avoided cost estimates in its 2008 PURPA Report. In the event IPL revises its avoided costs estimates again before the 2010

PURPA Report is due, IPL will be required to file an amended 2008 PURPA Report reflecting the changes to its avoided cost estimates.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. Interstate Power and Light Company shall file, within 20 days from the date of this order, revisions to its standard avoided cost tariff rates for small QFs (Tariff Sheet No. 50), based on IPL's 2008 PURPA Report, which was filed with the Board on June 30, 2008.

2. In the event IPL revises its avoided cost estimates prior to filing its 2010 PURPA Report, IPL shall file promptly an amended 2008 PURPA Report pursuant to 199 IAC 15.3.
