ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROPOSED TARIFFS

(Issued September 25, 2008)

On September 8, 2008, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) submitted to the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariffs designed to eliminate the option in current gas and electric tariffs that allow a customer to choose to pay a nonrefundable contribution in aid of construction for a gas main extension and an electric line extension. IPL stated that the proposed tariffs were based upon a waiver granted by the Board. The proposed electric tariff was identified as file TF-08-143 and the proposed gas tariff was identified as file TF-08-144.

On September 22, 2008, IPL filed a motion to withdraw the proposed tariffs. IPL states that it neglected to file the waiver request that was necessary to support the proposed tariff changes. IPL states that it will wait to resubmit the proposed tariff changes until the Board has issued an order regarding the waiver request. IPL filed the waiver request on September 15, 2008.

The Board will grant the motion to withdraw the proposed tariffs. Since the waiver request was not filed with the Board until September 15, 2008, there is not

sufficient time for the Board to review the waiver request before the effective date of the proposed tariffs. IPL may file appropriate proposed tariff changes once the Board has issued an order regarding the waiver request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The motion to withdraw the proposed tariffs submitted by Interstate Power and Light Company and identified as file nos. TF-08-143 and TF-08-144 is granted.
