**ORDER GRANTING MOTION
AND REQUIRING PROPOSED BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

(Issued October 6, 2008)

On October 2, 2008, Midwest Renewable Energy Projects II, LLC (MREP) filed a motion with the Utilities Board (Board) for leave to file two post-hearing exhibits, one confidential and one public. Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) do not object to the grant of the motion. The motion is reasonable and should be granted.

In addition, MREP seeks permission to file the confidential document in electronic form on a CD. MREP proposes to file two CD copies, one hard-copy printout, and a paper index of the contents of the CD. This is acceptable, although

the Board will need two hard-copy printouts and an original plus two copies of the paper index of the contents of the CD.

On August 5, 2008, the undersigned issued an order setting a briefing schedule. At the request of MREP, the briefing schedule was suspended in an order issued August 21, 2008. A briefing schedule will now need to be set. Since MREP will be filing its post-hearing exhibits, it is unclear whether the parties still agree that simultaneous briefs are appropriate. Therefore, the parties must file a proposed briefing schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The "Unresisted Motion for Leave to File Post-Hearing Exhibits" filed by MREP on October 2, 2008, is hereby granted. MREP's request to file the confidential exhibit in electronic form is granted, although MREP must file two CD copies, two hard-copy printouts of the exhibit, and an original plus two copies of the paper index of the contents of the CD. MREP must work with the Board's Records and Information Center to ensure that the CD can be read by the Board's system.

2. The parties must file a proposed briefing schedule on or before October 17, 2008.
