AMENDED PIPELINE PERMIT

(Issued October 16, 2008)

Permit No. 1070 Lateral Northrup King Lateral

Permission is hereby granted to Interstate Power and Light Company to construct, operate, and maintain pipelines in Muscatine and Johnson counties, Iowa, for the transportation of natural gas at a maximum operating pressure of 275 psig for approximately 2.9 miles over the route attached to and incorporated by reference in this permit.

Permit No. 1070 is granted subject to the provisions of Iowa Code Chapter 479 (2007), 199 Iowa Administrative Code Chapters 9 and 10 (2008), and the September 24, 2008, "Proposed Decision and Order Granting Permit Amendment" issued in this docket.

Permit No. 1070 shall be effective until January 17, 2014, unless revoked, terminated, or amended by the Utilities Board.

Legal Description of Existing Pipeline Route through Muscatine County, Iowa:

A 4 inch natural gas pipeline installed entirely on private property other than where it crosses public roads, commencing at a point in the South side of the pressure regulating station located on Interstate Power and Light Company's Conesville to West Branch Lateral. Said regulating station is in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eighteen (18), Township Seventy-Seven North (T77N), Range Four West (R4W) of the 5th P.M., Muscatine County, Iowa. Thence Westerly-Northwesterly (WNW'ly), across the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of aforesaid Section Eighteen (18), thence Northwesterly (NW'ly) across the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven (7), T77N, R4W, to a point on the West line of the aforesaid Southwest Quarter of Section 7, which is also the West line of Muscatine County, Iowa.

Legal Description of Existing Pipeline Route through Johnson County, Iowa:

A 4 inch gas pipeline installed entirely on private property other than where it crosses public roads, commencing at a point on the East line of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twelve (12), township Seventy-Seven North (T77N), Range Five West (R5W) of the 5th P.M., Johnson County, Iowa. (Said point is also the West line of Section 7, T77N, R4W, Muscatine County, Iowa.)

Thence, traveling parallel to the abandoned railroad right-of-way, Northwesterly (NW'ly) across the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twelve (12), across the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), and the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twelve (12).

Thence Westerly and Northwesterly (WNW'ly) across the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), same Township and Range as described above, to a point in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Eleven (11). Thence North approximately 1000 feet, to the point of delivery, in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), Township Seventy-Seven North (T77N), Range Five West (R5W), of the 5th P.M., Johnson County, Iowa.
