Permit No. 1237 Lateral Council Bluffs Lateral

Permission is hereby granted to Southwest Iowa Renewable Energy, LLC to construct, operate, and maintain pipelines in Pottawattamie County, Iowa, for the transportation of natural gas at a maximum operating pressure of 720 psig for approximately 0.65 miles over the route attached to and incorporated by reference in this permit.

Permit No. 1237 is granted subject to the provisions of Iowa Code Chapter 479 (2007), 199 Iowa Administrative Code Chapters 9 and 10 (2007), and the October 2, 2008, "Proposed Decision and Order Granting Permit" issued in this docket.

Permit No. 1237 shall be effective until October 16, 2033, unless revoked, terminated, or amended by the Utilities Board.

Exhibit A – Legal Descriptions

The entire pipeline route traverses across private property with the exception of public road crossings. The pipeline crosses one U.S. Highway (I-29) and two county roads. The project crosses only one landowner. The easement obtained from the landowner will be 20-feet wide, with an additional 35 feet of temporary workspace to ensure an adequate working area during construction.

The pipeline originates at a proposed Northern Natural Gas Town Border Station (TBS) in the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, T74N, R43W, Pottawattamie County, Iowa. The entire length of the pipeline will be in Pottawattamie County.

The proposed SIRE Pipeline will proceed west across 192nd Street, I-29 and 189th Street into the SIRE property in the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, T74N, R43W, there terminating.
