**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF
AND DISMISSING OMNITEL COMMUNICATIONS, INC.**

(Issued October 23, 2008)

On July 25, 2008, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC, d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services, and MCI Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Verizon Business Services (collectively "Verizon"), filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to dismiss respondent OmniTel Communications, Inc. (OmniTel), from its complaint. In support of that request, Verizon stated that it resolved its

dispute with OmniTel, which was the subject of this action, and therefore Verizon asked to dismiss OmniTel from the complaint with prejudice.

On August 29, 2008, the Board issued an order conditionally granting Verizon's request. The Board stated that it would approve the proposed settlement between Verizon and OmniTel upon the Board's approval of an amendment to OmniTel's intrastate access services tariff that specifies the rate agreed to for the origination and termination of intrastate switched access services and makes that rate available to all qualifying interexchange carriers.

On September 24, 2008, OmniTel filed with the Board a proposed revision to its intrastate access services tariff, identified as TF-08-154, which contains the terms and conditions for intrastate originating and terminating traffic.

The Board has reviewed OmniTel's proposed access tariff and finds that it substantially complies with the Board's rules for the filing and processing of tariff pages. Notice was provided to all affected carriers. The Board will approve the tariff effective the date of this order. Because the Board approves the amendment to OmniTel's intrastate access services tariff, the Board will also dismiss OmniTel from this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The tariff filed by OmniTel Communications, Inc., on September 24, 2008, identified as TF-08-154, is approved, effective the date of this order.

2. OmniTel Communications, Inc., is dismissed from this proceeding pursuant to the request filed by MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC, d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services, and MCI Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Verizon Business Services, on July 25, 2008.
