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**ORDER APPROVING REVISED ANNUAL PURCHASED  
GAS ADJUSTMENT RECONCILIATION FILING**

(Issued October 24, 2008)

On October 1, 2008, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) IPL's annual purchased gas adjustment (PGA) reconciliation for the period ending August 31, 2008. On October 15, 2008, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice (Consumer Advocate) filed a conditional objection to the October 1, 2008, filing. Consumer Advocate stated that it needed additional time to complete its review of the filing. The filing was identified as Docket No. PGA-08-43.

Based upon the objection of Consumer Advocate, on October 20, 2008, the Board issued an order docketing the annual PGA reconciliation for further review. On October 22, 2008, IPL filed a revision to the filing, and also on October 22, 2008, Consumer Advocate withdrew its objection.

The annual PGA reconciliation filing, as revised on October 22, 2008, appears to comply with the Board's rules and the Board will approve the filing. IPL's filing contains support for the E factors that will be included in the monthly PGA factor each

month beginning with the November 2008 billing cycle. The E factors are reflected in the revised tariff sheet filed on October 22, 2008.

The annual PGA reconciliation filing shows that IPL overcollected \$6,457,078 from the Firm customer class. As a result of the overcollection, the E factor for the Firm customer class is \$0.0265. The annual PGA reconciliation filing shows that IPL overcollected \$1,289,528 from the Interruptible customer class. Since the overcollection of \$1,289,528 from the Interruptible customer class is more than 3 percent of the gas cost for the class, pursuant to 199 IAC 19.10(7)"b"(1), the refunds to interruptible customers will be by bill credit. The E factor for the Interruptible class will therefore be \$0.000.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

The annual reconciliation filing made by Interstate Power and Light Company for the period ending August 31, 2008, as revised on October 22, 2008, is approved, subject to complaint and investigation.
