ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

(Issued November 25, 2008)

On January 7, 2008, Richard W. Lozier, an Iowa attorney representing AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha (collectively "AT&T") in this proceeding, filed an application for admission pro hac vice to allow out-of-state attorney Mr. Brendan James McMurrer to appear as attorney on behalf of AT&T in this proceeding. The application states that Mr. McMurrer is an attorney licensed to practice law in the District of Columbia and the state of Virginia and is a member in good standing of the bars of those jurisdictions.

On October 21, 2008, Richard W. Lozier, an Iowa attorney representing AT&T in this proceeding, filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a request to allow out-of-state attorney Ms. Letty S. D. Friesen to appear as attorney on behalf of AT&T in this proceeding. In support of his request, Mr. Lozier states that Ms. Friesen is licensed to practice law in the state of Colorado and is a member in good standing of the bar of that jurisdiction.

On October 30, 2008, Thomas G. Fisher, Jr., an Iowa attorney representing Great Lakes Communication Corp. (Great Lakes) and Superior Telephone Cooperative (Superior) in this proceeding, filed a request to allow out-of-state attorney Ms. Stephanie A. Joyce to appear as attorney on behalf of Great Lakes and Superior. In support of his request, Mr. Fisher states that Ms. Joyce is licensed to practice law in the state of California and the District of Columbia and is a member in good standing of the bars of those jurisdictions.

The requests appear to be in full compliance with 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e" and include the written appearance of Iowa-resident attorneys upon whom service may be made in all matters connected with this case pursuant to Iowa Supreme Court rule 31.14. The motions for admission pro hac vice will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The application for admission pro hac vice filed on January 7, 2008, by AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha is granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e." Mr. Brendan James McMurrer is authorized to appear in this proceeding as attorney on behalf of AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha.
2. The motion for admission pro hac vice filed on October 21, 2008, by AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha is granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e." Ms. Lettie S. D. Friesen is authorized to appear in this proceeding as attorney on behalf of AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc., and TCG Omaha.
3. The motion for admission pro hac vice filed on October 30, 2008, by Great Lakes Communication Corp. and Superior Telephone Cooperative is granted pursuant to 199 IAC 7.2(7)"e." Ms. Stephanie A. Joyce is authorized to appear in this
