IN RE: MIDAMERICAN ENERGY COMPANY	DOCKET NO. TF-08-198 (RPU-04-2)
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ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

(Issued December 17, 2008)

On November 20, 2008, MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) a proposed tariff, identified as TF-08-198, in accordance with its long-term rate equalization plan approved by the Board in Docket No. RPU-04-2. Specifically, MidAmerican proposes to reduce four South pricing zone residential rate codes by a uniform \$0.00089/kWh. MidAmerican is not reducing residential base-use electric rates for the East pricing zones because rates for the East zone are already below the \$0.088/kWh target. Pursuant to the terms of its Docket No. RPU-04-2 equalization plan, MidAmerican is not offsetting the reductions with rate increases to other customers. No objections to the proposed tariff were filed.

The Board will approve the proposed tariff. The tariff changes are consistent with the equalization plan addressed in the Board's June 19, 2006, order in Docket No. RPU-04-2 (TF-04-150, APP-96-1, RPU-96-8). The Board notes that this filing represents the last of MidAmerican's selective and limited equalization filings that involve rate reductions only, with no corresponding rate increases. The next phase

of MidAmerican's long-term rate equalization plan is expected to be its comprehensive class cost-of-service study and rate equalization/rate consolidation process, as outlined in the Board's June 19, 2006, order, referenced above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Tariff filing TF-08-198 is approved, subject to complaint or investigation, effective with bills issued on or after January 2, 2009.
