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**ORDER DOCKETING PROPOSED TARIFFS FOR FURTHER REVIEW
AND ESTABLISHING RESPONSE DEADLINES**

(Issued December 23, 2008)

On November 26, 2008, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed with the Utilities Board (Board) proposed tariffs relating to the relocation of IPL's electric and gas facilities at the request of a governmental unit. The proposed tariffs have been identified as TF-08-204 (electric) and TF-08-205 (gas).

On December 16, 2008, the cities of Dubuque and Clear Lake, Iowa, each filed a motion to strike and objections to the proposed tariffs. Among other things, the motions and objections allege that IPL did not give proper notice of the proposed tariffs and that the tariffs impinge on the franchise authority of cities.

The Board will docket the proposed tariff for further review by the Board and set a schedule for responses. IPL shall respond to the motion to strike and objections to the tariffs on or before January 2, 2009; Dubuque and Clear Lake may file replies on or before January 13, 2009. The Board will determine what additional procedural schedule, if any, needs to be established after it has reviewed the proposed tariffs, motions, responses, and replies.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Tariff filings TF-08-204 and TF-08-205 are docketed for further review.
2. Interstate Power and Light Company shall file responses to the motions to strike and objections on or before January 2, 2009.
3. The cities of Dubuque and Clear Lake may file replies to IPL's responses on or before January 13, 2009.
