Iowa Utilities Board launches new website

New site adapts display to all user devices, smartphone, tablet and desktop

(Des Moines) – With the increasing use of mobile devices, the Iowa Utilities Board launched a new website Thursday to help connect more Iowans to utility-related information.

The new website improves navigation and makes it easier to reach the Board. It also has a different web address: <https://iub.iowa.gov>.

The redesigned website is responsive, which means the site adapts the display to any user device, smartphone, tablet or desktop computer.

“Consumers and those interested in utility regulation can now more easily access information through the Board’s new website. Our goal for the redesign was to make the site much more user friendly, both in lay out and navigation, as well as on all types of mobile devices,” said Iowa Utilities Board Chair Libby Jacobs.

Users accessing the new site can quickly locate information about proposed projects before the Board, consumer services and program information, links to filing a complaint about utility service, how to access public documents or to make a filing with the Board, live streaming video of Board hearing and decision meetings, links to online services, and other key information for utility customers, utility professionals and stakeholders.
