Iowa Utilities Board schedules public meeting

(Des Moines, IA) – On Tuesday, August 18, 2015, the Iowa Utilities Board will hold a public meeting to discuss agency issues and help inform the public and utility industry stakeholders about various dockets and functions of the Board.

During the meeting, the Board will hold a hearing starting at 9:00 a.m. regarding a customer complaint identified as Arti, LLC v. MidAmerican Energy Company, Docket No. FCU-2014-0016. It is anticipated the hearing will take approximately three hours and may involve closed sessions to receive and discuss information that is confidential under Iowa law.

Upon completion of the hearing, the Board will recess the meeting to reconvene at 1:00 p.m. or 45 minutes after completion of the hearing, whichever is later, at which time the Board will discuss and act upon other dockets and matters identified in the official notice on the Board's hearing and meeting calendar at, <https://iub.iowa.gov/hearing-calendar> and the meeting agenda, which is available on the home page of the Board's web site at <https://iub.iowa.gov>.
