Iowa Utilities Board to hold public comment meetings in Iowa American Water rate case

(Des Moines) – Iowa American Water Company has filed an application with the Iowa Utilities Board for an increase in its water utility rates and charges in [Docket No. RPU-2016-0002](#). Iowa American provides water service to nearly 63,000 customers in Clinton, Davenport, Dixon, Bettendorf, LeClaire, Riverdale, Panorama Park and surrounding parts of Scott County.

The Board has [scheduled three consumer comment hearings](#) for Iowa American's customers to express their views about the upcoming rate case and the general quality of service provided by Iowa American. These consumer comment hearings are scheduled as follows:

- **Bettendorf** - Monday, May 23, 2016 @ 4:30 p.m. Scott Community College Student Life Center, Room 2300, 500 Belmont Road
- **Clinton** - Tuesday, May 24, 2016 @ 5:30 p.m. Clinton Community College Technology Center, Room 10, 1951 Manufacturing Drive
- **Dixon** - Tuesday, June 14, 2016 @ 5:30 p.m. The American Legion, 406 Davenport Street
